### **Riding with confidence**

Have you been too afraid to saddle up and go for a ride due to lack of confidence; in yourself or your horse? The first step is learning to be an effective leader by beginning on the ground. Then as you learn to 'talk your horses' language, you will gain trust in yourself and your horse and be on your way to ride safely and confidently.

### **Intermediate Riding**

For riders who have attended a groundwork course and are ready for more refinement in their riding. Learn how to get in time with and feel the feet and be a more fluid rider.

For riders who have attended horsemanship courses here at the facility. This will not be a clinic, but rather a self directed drop-in night for like minded horse enthusiasts.

### ***BOARD AVAILABLE***

Double W Horsemanship Academy is a privately owned and operated horse boarding facility devoted to the proper care of your horse. We welcome equestrians of all disciplines and breeds. Our 100-acre facility is composed of safely fenced pastures, open fields, and both indoor and outdoor stalls. Horses at Double W enjoy hours of peaceful grazing, high quality feed, and individual on-site care from experienced horse people.

Our facility consists of a 180'x60' heated indoor arena, 40'x60' heated warm up area, outdoor ring, outdoor training area with 4 round pens c/w cross-country jumps, 10'x12' matted stalls, and 10'x20' covered pens. The arena and attached barn area has natural lighting, fans, stereo and microphone set-up, viewing lounge, restroom, ample tack storage and meeting/class room. The facility also boasts an in-house trainer/clinician, large grass turnouts, twice daily feedings, high quality hay and optional mineral supplement, record keeping, and regular farrier/vet visits.

Location: 3/4 mile South of Hwy 20 on Range Road 31. Our facility is just 1 hr NW of Red Deer, 1 hr SW of Edmonton and 10 minutes north of Rimbey.

### ***OUTDOOR PASTURE BOARD \$250 +GST***

Horses are kept in a small herd environment and are closely observed to maintain safety.

Paddocks are spacious and equipped with horse shelters. Board includes hay and arena usage.

### ***OUTDOOR STALL BOARD \$350 +GST***

Horses are kept in 10'x20' covered sand pens and are closely observed to maintain safety.

Turnout pens are spacious and equipped with horse shelters. Board includes hay and arena usage.

### ***INDOOR STALL BOARD \$425 +GST***

Horses are kept in 10'x12' matted stalls and are cleaned and supplied with fresh shavings daily. Turnout pens are spacious and equipped with horse shelters. Board includes hay and arena usage.

Board includes hay and arena usage. Horses are turned out for a minimum of 4 hours/day.
